

What I found to be very effective when my Taku was diagnosed with lymphosarcoma was cottage cheese & flaxseed oil, mixed together. Something in the cottage cheese allows the body to assimilate the nutrients in the oil better. At any rate, most dogs live about 3 weeks after his type of cancer was discovered. Taku lived for three and a half months, and if he didn't have intussusception (telescoping of the bowels from spasming) and adhesions (like bands of scar tissue welding it all to his back), I believe he would have lived longer.
